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Note: The directions below assume you are traveling in either a northerly or southerly direction and stopping at every Challenge location – including bonus sites.

Pemaquid Point Lighthouse – Bristol – *GPS Coordinates:* N 43 50.12 W 69 30.21

Information: The Town of Bristol charges a fee of \$2.00 per person for parking and use of the park (discounts apply for seniors and children) but this fee does not support the lighthouse. Donations at the lighthouse are welcome to support preservation. The lighthouse will be open 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.

From Points South (108 miles or approximately 2 hours and 15 minutes from Maine Turnpike York Toll Plaza): From I-95, take exit 44 in South Portland and travel north on I-295. Take Exit 28 in Brunswick and proceed north on US-1. Continue on US-1 for approximately 27 miles and take exit to US-1 Business Route into town of Damariscotta, which becomes Main Street. After going over bridge and through downtown, take right onto US-129 South/Bristol Road. After 2.9 miles, take slight left onto US-130 South (still Bristol Road) and follow 11.5 miles. Take slight left and continue on Bristol Road for .3 miles. Lighthouse will be straight ahead.

From Marshall Point (52 miles or approximately 90 minutes): Follow ME-131 North for 16 miles. Turn left onto US-1 in Thomaston. Follow US-1 for 11 miles. Turn left onto ME-32. Follow ME-32 for 19.5 miles. Turn left on ME-130 for 1 mile to the lighthouse.

Marshall Point Lighthouse – Port Clyde – *GPS Coordinates:* N 43 55.03 W 69 15.41

Information: There is no charge but donations are always welcome. The museum in the keeper's house and the tower will be open from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday. A Lighthouse Challenge representative will be present from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday.

From Pemaquid Point (52 miles or approximately 90 minutes): Follow ME-130 1 mile to ME-32. Turn right onto ME-32 and follow for 19.5 miles. Turn right onto Route 1 North. Follow Route 1 for 12.5 miles to ME-131. Turn right onto ME-131 and follow for 13.8 miles. Turn left onto Drift Inn Road (signs will be posted). Turn right on Marshall Point Road. The lighthouse is straight ahead.

From Owls Head (22 miles or approximately 50 minutes): Turn left on ME-73. Follow ME-73 for 2.2 miles and turn right on Westbrook Street. Follow Westbrook Street for 2 miles to ME-131. Turn left onto ME-131 and follow for 12 miles. Turn left on Drift Inn Road (signs will be posted). Turn right on Marshall Point Road. Lighthouse is straight ahead.

Owls Head Lighthouse – Owls Head – *GPS Coordinates:* N 44 05.33 W 69 02.39

Information: Donations to support maintenance of the lighthouse are always welcome in the box next to the lighthouse. The tower will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday.

From Marshall Point (22 miles or approximately 50 minutes): Follow Marshall Point Road and turn left on Drift Inn Road. Turn right on ME-131. Follow for 12 miles. Turn right on Westbrook Street and follow for 2 miles. Turn left on ME-73. Follow 2.2 miles and turn right onto North Shore Drive. Follow signs for 3.4 miles to Owls Head Light State Park.

From Maine Lighthouse Museum (6 miles or approximately 15 minutes): From Park Drive turn left at light onto ME-73 South for 1.8 miles. Turn left onto North Shore Drive and follow signs 3.4 miles to Owls Head Light State Park.

American Lighthouse Foundation – Owls Head – *GPS Coordinates:* N 44 05.33 W 69 02.39

Information: The Interpretive Center and Gift Store, located in the Owls Head Light Station Keeper's House at 186 Lighthouse Road, will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Phone number is 207-594-4174.

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From Marshall Point (22 miles or approximately 50 minutes): Follow Marshall Point Road and turn left on Drift Inn Road. Turn right on ME-131. Follow for 12 miles. Turn right on Westbrook Street and follow for 2 miles. Turn left on ME-73. Follow 2.2 miles and turn right onto North Shore Drive. Follow signs for 3.4 miles to Owls Head Light State Park.

From Maine Lighthouse Museum (6 miles or approximately 15 minutes): From Park Drive turn left at light onto ME-73 South for 1.8 miles. Turn left onto North Shore Drive and follow signs 3.4 miles to Owls Head Light State Park.

Maine Lighthouse Museum – Rockland – *GPS Coordinates:* N 44 06.07 W 69 06.29

Information: The museum, located at 1 Park Drive, will be open from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. There is ample parking in front of the Museum or in the Trade Winds Motel parking lot across the street. For those wanting to tour the museum, admission is \$5.00 for adults, \$4.00 for seniors and children under 12 are free. Phone number is 207-594-3301.

From Owls Head & American Lighthouse Foundation (6 miles or approximately 15 minutes): Follow North Shore Drive to ME-73. Turn right onto ME-73 and follow 1.8 miles to intersection with US-1/Park Street. Turn right at light on Park Drive and the Museum will be on the right.

From Rockland Breakwater (2.6 miles or approximately 12 minutes): Follow Samoset Road to Waldo Avenue. Turn left onto Waldo Avenue and follow to US-1. Turn left onto US-1 South for 1.5 miles, then turn left at traffic light onto US-1 North/Park Street and get into right lane. At next traffic light, go straight through intersection and the museum will be on your right.

Rockland Breakwater Lighthouse – Rockland – *GPS Coordinates, lighthouse:* N 44 06.15 W 69 04.39; *parking lot:* N 44 06.959 W 69 05.058

Information: Please note the information at the kiosk located in the park about the lighthouse and walking the breakwater. The walk from the parking lot to the lighthouse on the granite breakwater takes approximately 25 minutes. There is a suggested donation to climb the tower. The lighthouse will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.

Water Transportation: To be determined.

From Maine Lighthouse Museum (1 mile or approximately 5 minutes): Follow Park Drive back to traffic light and intersection with US-1. Turn right onto Main Street/US-1 North and follow 1.4 miles. Turn right onto Waldo Avenue (there is a lighthouse sign at the traffic light) and follow for .5 miles, then turn right onto Samoset Road and proceed .6 miles to end/parking area.

From Curtis Island and Indian Island Lighthouses via Camden Harbor Cruises (7.9 miles or approximately 15 minutes): Travel on US-1 South for 6.8 miles to Rockland. Turn left onto Waldo Avenue (there is a lighthouse sign at the traffic light) and follow for .5 miles, then turn right onto Samoset Road and proceed .5 miles to end/parking area.

Curtis Island and Indian Island Lighthouses via Camden Harbor Cruises - 2 Public Landing, Camden - *GPS Coordinates:* N 44 12.35 W 69 03.51

Information: On Saturday beginning at 9:30 a.m. and Sunday beginning at 12:30 p.m. (and into the evening on both days), Camden Harbor Cruises offers an hour-long excursion with water views of Curtis Island and Indian Island Lighthouses. At 9:30 a.m. on Sunday, a 2 ½ hour excursion is being offered that affords water views of Curtis Island, Indian Island, Rockland Breakwater, Owls Head and Browns Head Lighthouses. Book online at www.camdenharborcruises.com using the coupon code “CHALLENGE” and receive \$10 off the normal ticket price of either excursion, or reserve by calling 207-236-6672. Two-hour parking is available along downtown streets or at the Public Landing. All-day parking is available on Washington Street just past the fire station and on Atlantic Avenue just past the Camden Public Library, both within walking distance of the harbor. See special insert for more information.

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From Rockland Breakwater Lighthouse (7.9 miles or approximately 15 minutes): Follow Samoset Road to Waldo Avenue. Turn left onto Waldo Avenue to US-1. Turn right onto US-1 North and travel 6.8 miles to Camden. Turn right after Camden National Bank onto Bay View Street then an immediate left onto Commercial Street, following the length of the Cappy's Chowder House Restaurant building, then through the public parking lot to the harbor boardwalk. Look for the Camden Harbor Cruises umbrella, next to the small Harbormaster's "shack."

From Lincolnville Beach/Ferry (6.0 miles or approximately 12 minutes): Turn left onto US-1 South to Camden for 5.8 miles. Turn left onto Bay View Street (in between Cappy's Chowder House and Camden National Bank), then an immediate left onto Commercial Street, following the length of the Cappy's Chowder House Restaurant building, then through the public parking lot to the harbor boardwalk. Look for the Camden Harbor Cruises umbrella, next to the small Harbormaster's "shack."

Grindle Point Lighthouse – Islesboro – *GPS Coordinates, lighthouse:* N 44 16.56 W 68 56.34;

Lincolnville Ferry Terminal: N 44 16.962 W 69 00.431

Information: The lighthouse is at the ferry landing on Islesboro so a car is not required on the ferry. The ferry departs Lincolnville Beach on the hour from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (except 12:00 p.m.), and returns from Islesboro on the half-hour from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (except 11:30 a.m.). Crossing time is 20 minutes. The ferry terminal office is closed between 11:00 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. Round trip rates are \$10.00 for adults (and children 12 and older) and \$4.75 for children ages 5 to 11 (under 5 are free). Round trip rate for a vehicle starts at \$27.50. Parking at Lincolnville Beach is available for \$10.00. *Note #1:* There is an "Excursion Ticket" priced at \$6.00 for adults and \$3.00 for children available for all but the last departure time; however, it requires that you return on the very next ferry back to the mainland, which is doable as the lighthouse is right next to the ferry terminal. *Suggestion:* Take the 11:00 a.m. ferry to enjoy the most time at the lighthouse, as the next return ferry is not until 12:30 p.m. *Note #2:* Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Due to traffic load in the summer season, actual departure times may vary significantly from the posted schedule. Anticipate delays and plan accordingly. For the most up-to-date information, call the Maine State Ferry Service Lincolnville Terminal at 207-789-5611. The lighthouse will be open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.

From Curtis Island and Indian Island Lighthouses via Camden Harbor Cruises (6.0 miles or approximately 12 minutes): Travel on US-1 North for 5.8 miles, to the blinking light at Lincolnville Beach. Turn right at the blinking light and proceed to Islesboro Ferry Terminal.

From Fort Point (27 miles or approximately 40 minutes): Follow Cape Jellison Road back to Main Street. Turn left and travel .3 mile to US-1. Turn left onto US-1 South and travel 22.6 miles to Lincolnville Beach. Turn left at blinking light and proceed to Islesboro Ferry Terminal.

Fort Point Lighthouse – Stockton Springs – *GPS Coordinates:* N 44 28.02 W 68 48.42

Information: The tower will be open to climb from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. A Lighthouse Challenge representative will be present from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day.

From Grindle Point (27 miles or approximately 40 minutes):

Return to mainland. Follow US-1 North for 22.6 miles to Stockton Springs, then turn right onto Main Street (right after Stockton Springs town line and sign for Fort Point State Park). Follow Main Street for .6 mile, turn right onto Cape Jellison Road and travel 2.7 miles (past the Fort Point State Park entrance), then turn left on Lighthouse Road and proceed .9 mile to the lighthouse.

From Dyce Head (29 miles or approximately 60 minutes): Follow Battle Avenue 1.3 miles and take sharp left onto ME-166/Castine Road. Follow 6.9 miles to ME-175 North on ME-175 for 8 miles to US-1. Turn left on US-1 South for 9.1 miles to Stockton Springs and turn left onto Main Street (at sign to Fort Point State Park). Follow Main Street for .2 mile, turn left onto Cape Jellison Road and travel 2.7

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miles (past the Fort Point State Park entrance), then turn left on Lighthouse Road and proceed .9 mile to the lighthouse.

Dyce Head Lighthouse – Castine – *GPS Coordinates:* N 44 22.57 W 68 49.07

Information: Note the keeper's house is a private residence; please follow any signs to respect their privacy. The tower will be open to climb from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. A Lighthouse Challenge representative will be present from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day. **Note: On Saturday morning the Town of Orland holds their annual Orland River Day celebration which features a parade (from 10:00 a.m. to approximately 11:00 a.m.) whose route includes a portion of Route 175 outlined in the directions below. To avoid the parade, if traveling from the south or Fort Point, at the point where you are instructed to onto ME-175, instead continue on US-1 North for 1.2 miles, then turn right at the intersection with flashing yellow light onto School House Road and follow for .5 miles to the junction with ME-175. Turn left onto ME-175 and follow 7 miles to ME-166, then continue with the balance of directions below. If traveling from the east (US-1 South), after passing turn off for US-15, travel 1.4 miles and turn left at the intersection with flashing yellow light onto School House Road and follow for .5 miles to the junction with ME-175. Turn left onto ME-175 and follow 7 miles to ME-166, then continue with the balance of directions below.**

From Fort Point (29 miles or approximately 60 minutes): Follow Cape Jellison Road back to Main Street. Turn right and travel .3 mile to US-1. Turn right onto US-1 North and travel 9.1 miles. Turn right onto ME-175 South and follow 8 miles to ME-166. Continue on ME-166 for 1.9 miles, then turn right onto ME-166A for 3.8 miles to stop sign. Turn right onto ME-166/Castine Road and follow .9 mile and turn sharp right onto Battle Avenue (no sign). Continue 1.3 miles on Battle Avenue (passing Maine Maritime Academy on left) to lighthouse.

From Points East: Proceed on US-1 South towards Bucksport. At junction with ME-175 in Orland, turn left and follow 8 miles to ME-166. Continue on ME-166 for 1.9 miles, then turn right onto ME-166A for 3.8 miles to stop sign. Turn right onto ME-166/Castine Road and follow .9 mile and turn sharp right onto Battle Avenue (no sign). Continue 1.3 miles on Battle Avenue (passing Maine Maritime Academy on left) to lighthouse.
